How To Join SRGC:

Once your application is processed and approved, you will receive your key in the mail along with your membership ID card. Please have this card on your person at all times while on the club property as you are required to show it if/when you are asked by another member to verify your right to be there. We police ourselves here and have found that this method is the most effective in curbing any unwanted behavior.

Club Meetings:

There is a monthly SRGC Club meeting held on the FIRST Tuesday of every month. This meeting is not mandatory, but we strongly urge that all members attend. This is where all updates and any news is passed on to the members and where any issues that have arisen in the previous month are resolved. It's also a great time to bring forth any ideas you may have to improve the club.

Club Fees:

The Annual Dues are due during the first Club meeting every January. This is when current members bring their keys and when the yearly due is paid, you will receive the new keys to the locks. The old keys from the prior year will no longer work after this meeting, and this is the quickest way to ensure you will not lose access to the club for any length of time.
